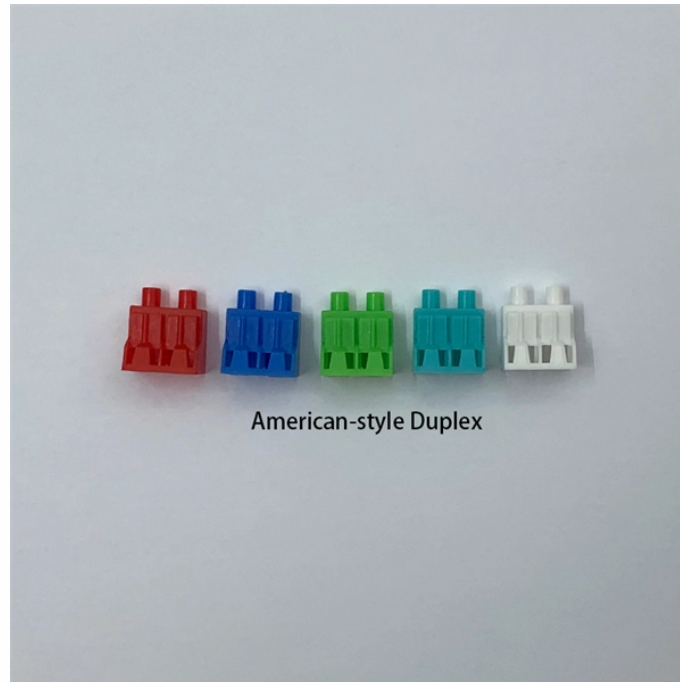


Accident involving fiber optic cable

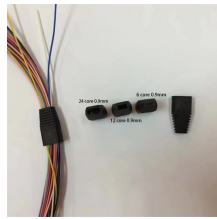
