Overview

This guide uses the DSC Power 864 security system with DSC accessories as an example to detail exactly how to wire a security system. Actual wiring diagrams and pictures are provided for real DSC products. See the Alarm Wiring guide. Hardwired home security systems need some basic alarm system wiring for main panel operation. Wiring a home alarm system is easiest to do while the house is. A security power supply, also known as a power distribution unit (PDU) or power distribution box, is a device that provides electrical power to various security system components, such as cameras, access control panels, and alarms. It takes power from a primary source (usually your building's). This power distribution panel is designed to accommodate a wide variety of applications; therefore, circuit breakers and compression lugs are sold separately. 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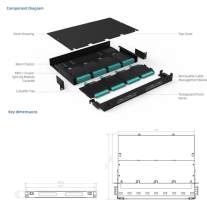

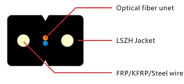

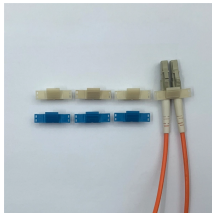
Wiring a home alarm system is easiest to do while the house is being built, but it can also be done in an existing home. This page focuses on the wiring needed for main panel functions.
