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Click Here Chad is a landlocked country in Central Africa. Chad's currency is the CFA franc. In the 1960s, the Mining industry of Chad produced sodium carbonate, or natron. However, years of civil war have scared away foreign. Huawei broke ground on a national data center in July 2020 and is building out a 4G network and fiberoptic cables through a concessional loan provided by China EXIM Bank. Through our collective efforts and technological innovation, we have enhanced internet connectivity. At the Global Symposium for Regulators (GSR-25) in Saudi Arabia, Haliki Choua Mahamat, the Director General of Chad's Electronic Communications and Posts Regulatory Authority (ARCEP), met with ITU Secretary-General Doreen Bogdan-Martin.

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While Chad is part of the Trans-Saharan Fiber Optic Backbone (TSB) alongside Niger, Nigeria, and Algeria, authorities stated in March 2025 that the Chadian portion of the project was only 32% complete.



Despite being landlocked at the heart of Africa, Chad is not isolated from the world, thanks to fiber optic cabling networks that make it easy to be actively involved in the world's internet domain.
