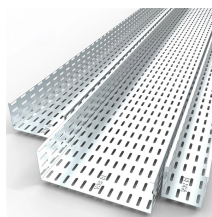
The 40 mm busbar system is used in machine and installation distribution boards, meter cabinets and power distribution systems in the lower performance range up to 400 A.



In principle, busbar protection is needed when the system protection does not protect the busbars, or when, in order to keep power system stability, high-speed short circuit current clearance is needed. ...

Busbar systems are becoming the predominant solution for manufacturers across nearly all global industries as a safer, more effective, and efficient method of powering control cabinets.

These types of protection are typically applied on distribution busbars, where fault current magnitudes are lower and speed is generally less critical than with transmission busbars.
