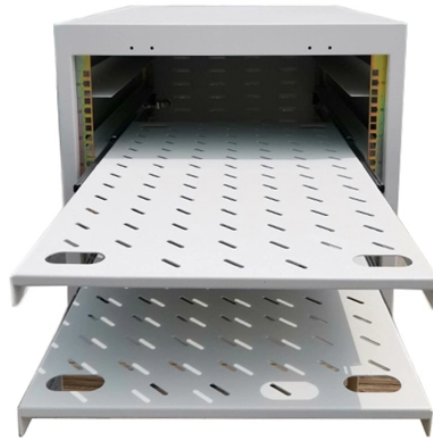


China Unicom fiber optic cable fell



Overview

The company has 60 days to cease providing domestic and international services in the country. The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) adopted an order revoking China Unicom (Americas) Operations Ltd. These fiber-optic lines stretch across the seafloor, making them ideal targets for sabotage with minimal resources, while creating just enough plausible deniability for malicious actors to dodge any consequences. To date, Taiwan's limited response to China's cable cutting (see discussion below) has. In February, American subsea cable company SubCom LLC began laying a \$600-million cable to transport data from Asia to Europe, via Africa and the Middle East, at super-fast speeds over 12,000 miles of fiber running along the seafloor.

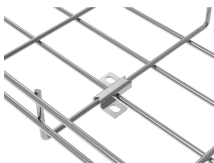

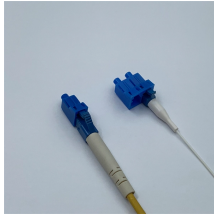
