

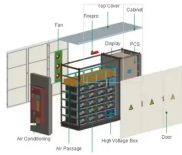

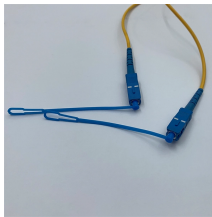

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm 2 (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm 2 must be used.



Wiring Direction: Wiring between the main circuit breaker and each branch circuit breaker in the box generally goes on the left, and the wiring out of the distribution box generally goes on the ...



Distributes all cable conductors to up to three locations (one "IN", three "OUTS") to increase the amount of floor boxes fed from a single Zone Distribution Box output whip.

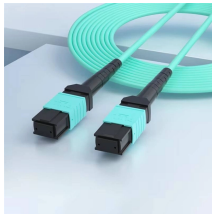
