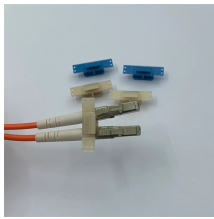

Using fusion splicing in the drop adds time and cost. The performance of a fiber optic splice is determined by a number of factors, including the quality of the fiber, the cleanliness of the splice, and the techniques used to make the splice. Prysmian has tested and recommends using the Benner-Nawman UP-B36 Cable Slitter for slitting the web during end access. Backbone cables of 144-288 fibers are common and larger ones are becoming more common too. Drop cables are often only 2-12 fibers, meaning most fibers are continuing. Fusion splicing is often used and is appropriate for trunk portions of a network; it offers low optical and reflection loss and splicing efficiency for large fiber bundles. Don't worry, you don't need to be an engineer to understand how they work. Another method of connecting optical fibers is termination or connectorization, which consists of processing the end of a fiber optic bundle so that it can be connected to other fibers or devices through fiber optic.

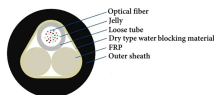

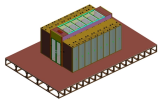
