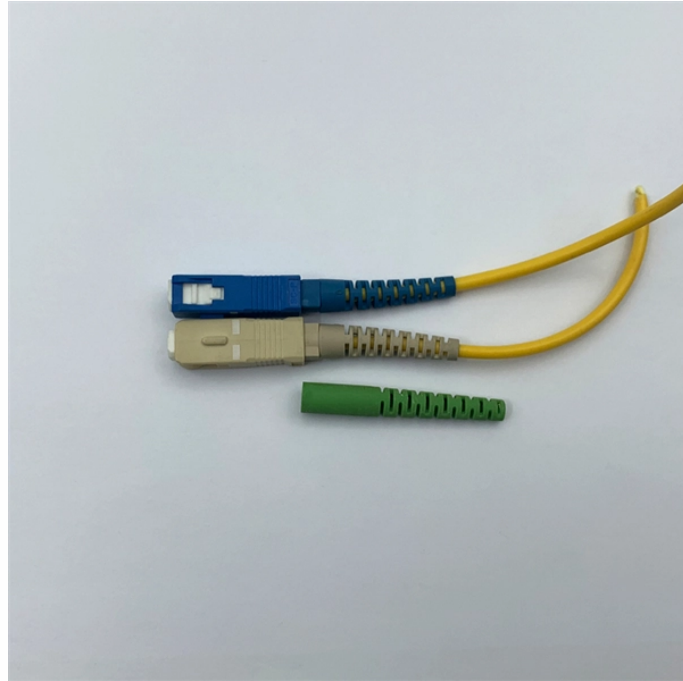

## Electrical distribution box placed in elevator lobby



The installation of all electrical wiring in hoistways and machine rooms, except as may be provided elsewhere in these regulations, shall comply with CCR, Title 24, Part 3, Article 620.



Not only does the Elevator Control Panelboard provide electrical feeds, it also contains necessary components for the control of the elevator and the fire alarm system.



Ducts and electrical conduit are permitted to pass through an elevator machine room or control room if they are separated from the room by construction equal to the rated construction of the room and so ...



Utility-owned electrical structures not directly concerned with electrical generation, transmission and distribution are NEC regulated. An example would be the elevator, as well as all wiring in a utility ...



Explanation-The 240VAC feed should have a black, red, white, and ground wire to the machine room. All electrical contractors will have full knowledge of this requirement. Simply insure they are aware of ...

The space equal to the width and depth of the equipment, and extending from grade to a height of 1.8 m (6 ft) above the equipment, shall be dedicated to the electrical installation.

First, you'll need to install lighting in the elevator equipment room (Photo 1) and shaft pit (Photo 2). Luminaires must be lensed or equipped with wire guards to protect the lamps. The light ...
