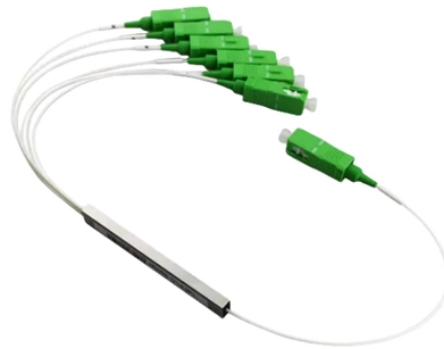


Guatemalan pigtail production base

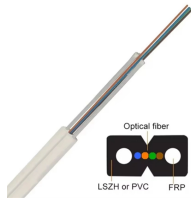


Overview

Agriculture: A Historical Pillar Agriculture remains Guatemala's backbone, with bananas, coffee, and cardamom topping the list. Cardamom continues to be a niche but high-value. In the last five years, beef consumption in Central America increased 4%, from 335,000 tons in 2014 to

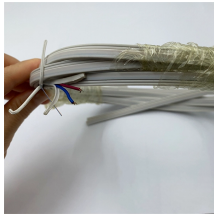
