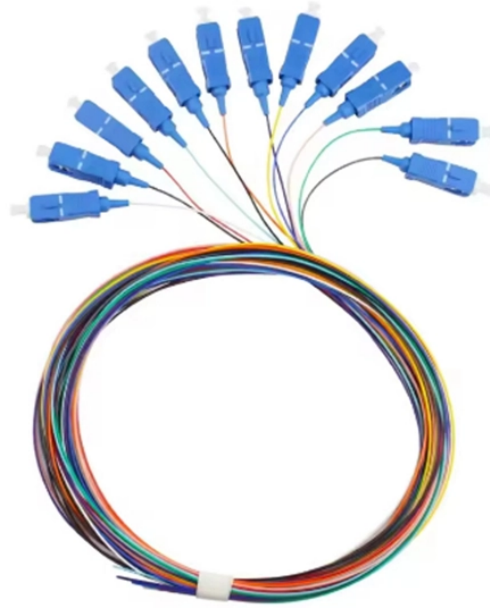

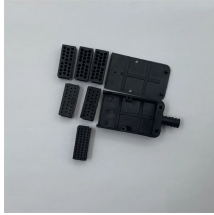

Specify horizontal/vertical bends, tees, reducers, drop-outs, and barriers. Choose radii that respect cable. The National Electrical Code (NEC) covers many aspects of cable tray supports and fittings. Typically, cable trays can span anywhere from 6 to 24 feet without additional. The supports are not placed at the ends of each tray sections, but, instead are located at a distance no greater than 1/4 of the length of the tray (eg. 1.5 meters for a 6 meter tray).



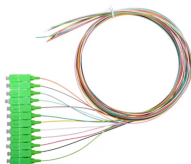

The National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) VE 1 standard is the primary guideline for specifying cable tray systems, particularly defining load capacity and span capabilities.



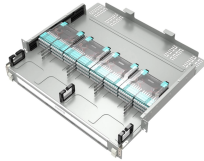
Standard length of 3, 4, and 6 meters Channel cable tray is used for installations with limited numbers of tray cable when conduit is undesirable. Support frequency with short to medium support spans of 1.5 ...



Typically, cable trays can span anywhere from 6 to 24 feet without additional support. Several factors influence the maximum span length of a cable tray: 1. Cable Weight. Heavier cables ...



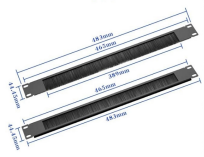
Trays shall be supported at a maximum span of 2.5m by trapeze, wall, floor or channel mounting methods and will not exceed maximum loads as specified by the manufacturer.



Commonly called the Load Class, this defines the load-carrying capability of the tray for a specific support span distance. The design and cost of the cable tray is greatly affected by this designation.



Pick a span (often 1.5–3 m) and verify the uniform load rating exceeds your cable weight plus a safety factor. Check deflection limits to protect terminations and fibre.
