

## How many square meters should the distribution box be



### Overview

The right size depends on internal layout, cable entry space, bend radius, heat, and future spare capacity. Quick rule: Do Standard Electrical Enclosure Sizes Exist?

Short answer: no single global chart. There isn't one master list that all brands follow. Deeper boxes are recommended when wire count is high. Are plastic and metal electrical box dimensions the same?

For distribution boxes that handle only lighting circuits or small power loads, if the incoming wire size is less than 10 square millimeters and the number of circuit switches is fewer than 20, the width of the box should be calculated by summing the width of the switches and adding an additional. for all enclosed conductors. 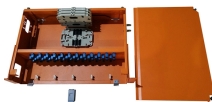
