

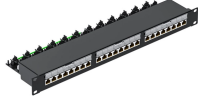
KVM switcher automatically adjusts resolution



Overview

To resolve this problem, try powering off and then restarting the KVM switch when everything is connected in the setup. KVM switch resolution issues are often caused by cheap adapters or monitor limits, not the KVM. Check your monitor's manual for true specs; manufacturers may advertise misleading refresh rates. Use quality adapters from the Avico Approved Adapter List. I tried. Namely, I have a new MacBookPro and a Windows PC both connected to the KVM which is in turn connected to a Samsung G9. I mostly use the Linux machine. When I run "Preferences->Display", the "Resolution" choices range from 1920x1200 down to 800x600. If I use the KVM switch to switch from the Linux machine to the Windows machine, I get a. I have a desktop machine with Ubuntu 22. 3 LTS and a Dell P2715Q monitor. If it works with the adjusted resolution, it might be an issue with resolution compatibility.

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The issue is that when the KVM switches between the two inputs, the PC's resolution is returned to it's native 640x480 resolution and I not means of changing it (greyed out). If I unplug and ...



It's possible that you configure EDID A on the controlled computer for screen mirroring, and then the KVM might automatically switch to EDID B. Your controlled computer might then ...



Most KVM's don't have EDID emulation built in unless spending many hundreds on something dedicated (TESmart, Level1Tech, ConnectPro etc), which means as soon as you switch ...

Sounds like the monitor EDID settings (what resolutions/refresh rates it supports) are not getting to Ubuntu when it's connected via the KVM. You can run xrandr to see what resolutions are ...



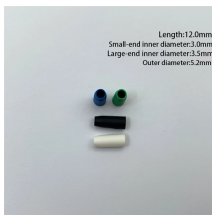

It is connected to a Windows 11 machine and a Linux Mint 21.3 machine via an logear displayport KVM switch. Both machines normally boot up with the monitor at a resolution of 1920x1200.

You shall try setting a lower resolution output (such as 720p or 1080p) and then reconnecting to the KVM switch to test if the monitor displays an image. If it works with the adjusted ...
