These port LEDs, as a group or individually, display information about the switch and about the individual ports. To select or change a mode, press the Mode button until the desired mode is ...



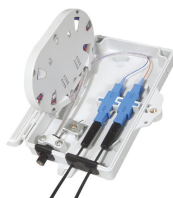
