

## On-site inspection of the distribution box



### Overview

- Ensure the distribution box has a "Personnel Working" sign before inspection.  Long.  Is the distribution box intact and free of obvious damage?
- Is there any water or abnormal liquid around the box?
- Open the box cover and check if the inside is dry.  Is the main switch in the correct position (usually ON)?
- Are the indicator lights for each circuit working properly (green. Forget cookie-cutter checklists - we're talking about the real, practical inspection points that determine whether a distribution box will perform flawlessly for decades or become an electrical hazard in five years. Inspect circuit breakers for proper operation. Ensure all connections are tight and secure.

This NEP covers both programmed and unprogrammed safety inspections, and all inspections will be conducted in accordance with provisions of the FOM, Chapter 3, Inspection Procedures.

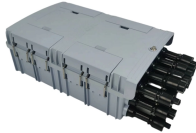

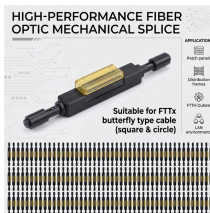
