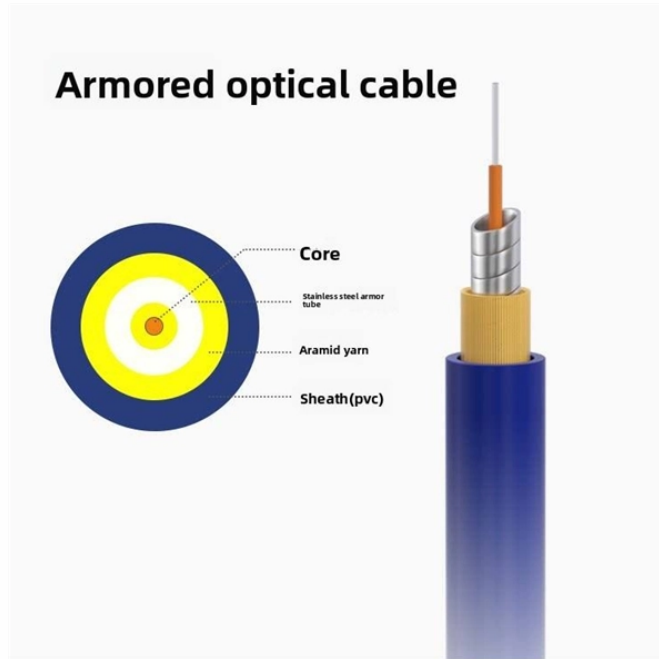


# Optical Cable Distribution Engineering Procedures

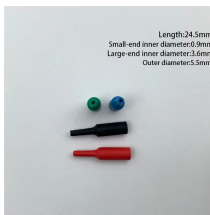
