

Quota Set for Aggregation Switches



Overview

This procedure explains how to create a quota management configuration using the APIC GUI. In the APIC GUI the quota can be configured globally or at the tenant level. What Is an Aggregation Switch and How to Choose?

The three layers of a traditional three-layer network design are the core layer, aggregation layer, and access layer. The Pro Aggregation does this with its SFP28 25Gbps ports.
