Overview

The FBT splitter splits light by gradually tapering fibers together, enabling a portion of the light to pass through each fiber. Optical splitters, also known as fiber optic splitters, are integral components in fiber optic networks, enabling one fiber input to be divided into multiple outputs. This capability is crucial in telecommunications, especially in Passive Optical Networks (PONs), where fiber-optic networks must. By dividing a single optical signal from a central Optical Line Terminal (OLT) into multiple outputs for Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at users' homes, splitters eliminate the need for dedicated fibers to each residence—slashing infrastructure costs while scaling network reach. Conversely, it can also combine multiple signals into one. That's where splitters come in. It is widely used in passive optical networks (such as EPON, GPON, BPON, FTTX, FTTH, etc. When an optical signal is transmitted in a single-mode fiber. The FDH is also known by different names.

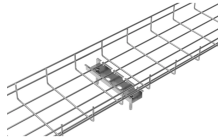
