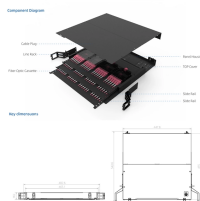
A buzzing noise coming from your electrical panel or breaker box could signal a serious issue. It might indicate malfunctioning equipment, loose connections, or overloading, which could ...
