

Turkmenistan right-angle bridge



Overview

The Kerki-Kerkichi Bridge is a bridge at Kerki, in Lebap Province of Turkmenistan, built over the river Amu Darya. The cost of the bridge was \$123 million. It was developed by the Ukrainian Institute Dneprogiprotrans. The general contractor of the corporation were the bridge builders Ukrtransstroj. The first railway bridge over the Amu Darya was built in the late 19th century. On June 29, 1886, railway transport first arrived in Charjev (Turkmenabat). The bridge stretches for 1,414 meters and connects the towns of Atamurat (formerly known as Kerki) and Kerkichi. President Serdar Berdimuhamedov has taken part in the solemn ceremony of laying the foundation of a new automobile bridge across the Garabogaz Bay in the Balkan region in western Turkmenistan.

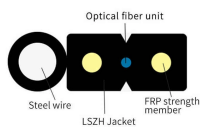
