Traditionally, protective relays were electromechanical devices that utilized induction disk, coils, contacts, and solenoid elements to determine protective characteristics.



A protection relay can detect the cause of a fault, such as overcurrent, overvoltage, or increases in temperature, that conventional protection devices cannot identify.
