

What do the dashed lines in the distribution box represent



Overview

In the box plot, the solid line indicates the median and the dashed line indicates the mean. The median thus divides the individuals into two equal. In descriptive statistics, a box plot or boxplot (also known as a box and whisker plot) is a type of chart often used in explanatory data analysis. We use these values to compare how close other data values are to them. Therefore, 25% of the data lie below Q1, 25% above Q3, and 50% within the box.

A box plot represents the five-number summary of a data set. It shows the first quartile (Q1) and the third quartile (Q3) as the left and right sides of a rectangle or a box.



The two whiskers extend from the first quartile to the smallest value and from the third quartile to the largest value. The median is shown with a dashed line.



When you do something, you take some action or perform an activity or task. Do is often used instead of a more specific verb, to talk about a common action involving a particular thing.



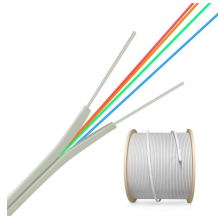

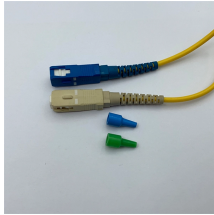
Box limits indicate the range of the central 50% of the data, with a central line marking the median value. Lines extend from each box to capture the range of ...

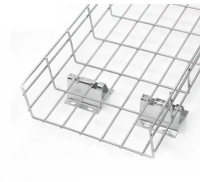
