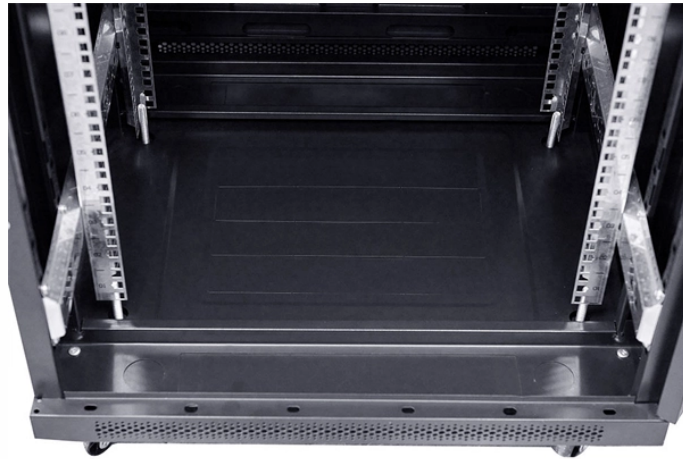


## Where is the best place to build bridges in the Democratic Republic of Congo
