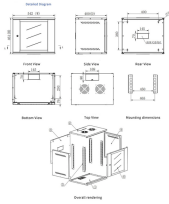


Overview

A distribution box uses MCBs, RCDs, and busbars to protect circuits, prevent shocks, and ensure safe power distribution in homes and buildings. You use a distribution box to divide electrical power into smaller circuits. The box usually contains switches, fuses, or. A distribution board (also known as panelboard, circuit breaker panel, breaker panel, circuit breaker, electric panel, fuse box or DB box) is a component of an electricity supply system that divides an electrical power feed into subsidiary circuits while providing a protective fuse or circuit. 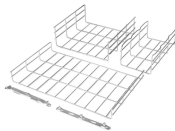

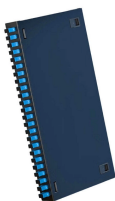
